To whom it may concern

Station Walk – footpath between Bramley Road and Silchester Road, to the east of the railway viaduct.

This footpath has been the subject of an extinguishment order. However, in order to address concerns raised by local residents, it is now Council policy for the path to remain open in perpetuity.

The route of the path will change slightly in order to accommodate the new academy and will require some construction work to be carried out. Therefore, in order to ensure public safety, the path will need to be closed temporarily at certain times during the construction process.

Any temporary closure will be advertised at least one week in advance by the posting of notices along Station Walk.
